1. Tour assigned school/district/other CMO schools (if applicable): Review logistics and compare with vision		
2. Attend BESE: Gain a grass roots understanding of state and federal mandates, governance and policy-making		
3. District/charter board meeting: Understand how decisions are made closer to the local level		
4. Attend Rotary luncheon (or Chamber meeting): Meet the business community and garner support		
5. District administrative networking: Become familiar with other administrators in the district/CMO		
6. Multidisciplinary team meeting/IEP meeting: Get a hands-on understanding of Special Education Policies and Procedures		
7. Discipline hearing: Understand and follow protocol and due process		
8. Field trip: View teacher(s) and students from a different perspective (and vice versa)		

9. Parent meetings: Piecing together the community to understand it – and students – as a whole		
10. State/district/CMO/school curriculum committee meeting(s): Learn how to change the curriculum that many people in schools complain about		
11. Attend a community foundation meeting: Meet the non-profit community		
12. Louisiana legislature: See policy makers and understand law-making process		
13. Regional or National conference: Expand ideas and network		
14. Meet with and interview the Superintendent/CMO CEO		
15. Present to the school board (during committee or meeting of the whole), PTO, staff meeting, parent meeting, community meeting, student assembly, etc.
